

CO-OP® “WASH & WIN FREE CAR WASHES FOR A YEAR” CONTEST

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES & REGULATIONS

The Wash & Win Free Car Washes for a Year Contest (the “**Contest**”) is sponsored by Federated Co-operatives Limited (the “**Sponsor**”). The Contest begins 12:00:00 am CT (Central Time) on October 5, 2020 (the “**Contest Start Date**”) and ends 11:59:59 pm CT on November 15, 2020 (the “**Contest Closing Date**”), known as the “**Contest Period**”. All dates and times are in Central Time.

1. HOW TO ENTER:

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. A purchase will not increase your chance of winning. To enter and receive one (1) Contest entry:

Step 1: Obtain a single Co-op Car Wash Code Receipt with the purchase of any single Co-op Car Wash at a Co-op car wash facility (“Participating Location”).

Step 2: To enter and receive one (1) Contest entry go online to www.cooppromotions.com, click on the “Wash & Win Free Car Washes for a Year” Contest link and complete the online registration form with the following information: full name, valid email address, postal code, phone number and valid single Co-op Car Wash Code Receipt. Limit one (1) entry per person regardless of the email address, telephone numbers per unique Co-op Car Wash Code Receipt.

To enter without purchase, print your name, address and daytime telephone number on a plain piece of paper and mail along to:

Total limit of *one (1)* Official Entry Form without purchase per day can be submitted. Each entry must be mailed in a separate envelope bearing sufficient postage.

All entries must be received on or before the Contest Closing Date.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

Eligible

To enter the Contest and be eligible to win a prize in the Contest, a person must be a resident of British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan or Manitoba, and the age of majority in the jurisdiction in which he or she resides as of the Contest Start Date.

Not Eligible

The Sponsor's employees and the Sponsor's Board of Director as well as the immediate family* and those domiciled with the Sponsor's employees and Board of Directors are not eligible to participate in the Contest or win prizes in the Contest.

Employees of the Sponsor's member retail co-operatives ("**Co-ops**"), the Co-ops' Board of Directors as well as the immediate family* and those domiciled with the Co-ops' employees and the Co-ops' Board of Directors are not eligible to participate in the Contest or win prizes in the Contest.

Employees of the Sponsor's and the Co-ops' operators, affiliates, agents, independent judging organization, consulting, advertising and promotional agencies, as well as those domiciled with and the immediate family* of the foregoing, are not eligible to participate in the Contest or win prizes in the Contest.

* "Immediate family" includes parents, siblings, children and spouses.

3. PRIZES:

Thirty Nine (39) Prizes of Fifty Five (55) Co-op Premium Car Wash Certificates which are redeemable at any Participating Location in Western Canada. Prize Certificates are fully transferrable and have no expiry date.

APPROXIMATE RETAIL VALUE *\$12,870.00 CDN*

Prizes must be accepted as awarded. Prizes may not be sold, converted to cash, are non-transferable, and no substitutions are permitted. One prize per winning entry; one prize per household. The Sponsor reserves the right, in the event that a prize or any component of a prize cannot be awarded as described for any reason, to substitute another prize of equal or greater value without liability.

The chances of being selected are dependent upon the total number of eligible entries received during the Contest Period.

4. PRIZE WINNER:

A random draw will be made on *November 17, 2020* at My Brother Darryl in Seagrave, ON from among all eligible entries received on or before the Contest Closing Date. There will be only one winner for each Co-op association. If there is more than one Participating Location in a Co-op association, My Brother Darryl will conduct a random draw on *November 17, 2020 at approximately 2:00pm* in Seagrave, ON from all entries received for that Co-op association. Selected entrants will be contacted by telephone within five (5) business days of the draw date. If a selected entrant cannot be contacted within five (5) business days of the draw date his/her entry will be disqualified and another entrant will be randomly selected. To be declared a prize winner (the "Prize Winner"), the selected entrant must: (1) correctly answer a mathematical skill testing question to be administered via telephone, mail or email; and (2) complete, sign and return a Statement of Compliance, Release and Indemnity Agreement to the Sponsor within five (5) business days of receipt of written prize notification or prize will be forfeited and an alternate Prize Winner

selected. Prize Winners consent to the use of their name, address (city and province) and photograph without compensation, in any future publicity carried out by the Sponsor.

5. GENERAL:

By entering the Contest, entrants agree to abide by these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor with respect to all aspects of the Contest, which are final. This Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws. All entries become the property of the Sponsor and none will be returned. By entering this Contest, entrants consent to the use of their name and address (city and province) by the Sponsor for the purposes stated herein.

The Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any entrant in the event of fraudulent Contest entry or other violation of these Official Rules. Entry forms are subject to verification and void if obtained illegitimately, or if altered, mutilated, forged, tampered with or irregular in any way.

Subject to applicable law, the Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion and for any reason, to cancel, terminate, modify these Official Rules or administration of the Contest or suspend this Contest in whole or in part without prior notice and with no obligation or liability. In the Sponsor's sole discretion, a Prize Winner may be selected by randomly drawing from among all valid entries received up to the time of cancellation, termination or suspension.

By participating in the Contest, entrants agree to release and indemnify the Sponsor and any independent judging organization as well as their respective parents, affiliates, member retail co-operatives, agents and contractors, including advertising and promotional agencies, and their directors, officers and employees, from any and all losses, expenses (including legal fees), damages and claims of any kind in connection with the Contest or resulting from the acceptance, possession or use of any prize, including without limitation any loss, personal injury, death, property damage, or claims based on publicity rights, defamation or invasion of privacy.

Under no circumstances will the Sponsor, its member retail co-operatives, subsidiaries, affiliates, independent contractors, and their respective directors, officers, employees, and agents, including advertising and promotional agencies, be responsible for any injuries, loss or damages of any kind (compensatory, direct, incidental, indirect, consequential or otherwise) with respect to or in any way arising from, this Contest or the prize awarded. In no event shall the Sponsor be required to award more prizes than what is indicated in these Official Rules or award the prizes otherwise than in accordance with these Official Rules.

6. PRIVACY:

The Sponsor, Federated Co-operatives Limited, respects your right to privacy. Personal information collected is not sold, rented or loaned to any third parties.

The Sponsor will use the information collected solely to administer the Contest. No correspondence will be entered into except with selected entrants.

Federated Co-operatives Limited will handle personal information in accordance with its privacy policies and practices, which can be accessed on its website www.fcl.crs or by contacting the privacy officer for Federated Co-operatives Limited at privacy@fcl.crs; and in accordance with applicable laws. By completing and submitting a Contest entry form you consent to the collection, use and disclosure of your personal information for the purposes stated herein.

7. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- i) **Verification.** Entries made online and request for participation without purchase are subject to verification by the Contest Organizer. Any entry that is, as the case may be, incomplete, incomprehensible, inaudible, illegible, fraudulent, mutilated, late, or which does not comply with the rules herein will automatically be rejected and will not entitle a person to an entry or a prize.
 - ii) **Disqualification.** The Contest Organizer reserve the right to disqualify any person or cancel one or more entries of any person entering this contest or who attempts to participate by means contrary to the rules herein or in a manner prejudicial to other participants (e.g., use of Entry Forms obtained from an unauthorized source, entries exceeding the allowable limit, computer hacking, etc.). Any attempt to deliberately damage the website or undermine the legitimate operation of this Contest is a violation of criminal and civil laws. If such an attempt is made, the Contest Organizer reserves the right to seek damages from that person, without prejudice to the rights of the Contest Organizer to seek any other remedies to the extent permitted by law. This person could be referred to the competent judicial authorities.
 - iii) **Non-compliance/eligibility.** Any participant who is selected at random as part of this contest and does not comply with the eligibility requirements herein will be automatically disqualified and another random draw will be held to select a participant. Any selected participant that does not comply with these eligibility conditions must inform the contest organizers as soon as they contacted him or her.
 - iv) **Acceptance of a prize.** All prizes must be accepted as described in these rules and cannot be transferred to another person, substituted for another prize or exchanged in part or in whole against money, subject to the provisions paragraph below.
 - v) **Substitution of a prize.** In the event that it was impossible, difficult and/or more costly for the Contest Organizer and/or the Prize Sponsor to award a prize (or a portion thereof) as described in these rules, they reserve the right to award a prize (or a portion of the prize) of similar nature and equivalent value or, at their sole discretion, the value of the prize (or a portion of the prize) indicated herein in cash.
 - vi) **Refusal to accept a prize.** The refusal of a person selected at random to accept a prize according to the terms herein releases the Contest Organizer and Prize Sponsor from any obligation related to prize to that person.
 - vii) **Limit of responsibility – use of a prize.** Any person selected releases the Contest Organizer, the Prize Sponsor, their affiliates and respective divisions and any other moral person of their respective corporate groups, their advertising and promotion agencies, their shareholders, directors, officers, employees, agents and representatives, suppliers of prizes, materials and services related to this contest, as well as any other party associated with this contest (hereinafter, the "**Beneficiaries**") from any liability for any damages that may occur due to the acceptance or use of the prize. To be declared

a winner, and before obtaining the prize, the selected person agrees to sign a Declaration Form to this effect.

- viii) **Responsibility – operation of the Contest.** The Beneficiaries disclaim any liability with respect to: the malfunctioning of any computer component, software or communications line; any faulty, incomplete, or incomprehensible transaction or any transaction erased by any computer or any network, and which may limit or prevent any person from entering the Contest; any technical or human error which may occur in the treatment of or participation in the Contest; problems with the functioning of the website or features of the website, regardless of cause; malfunction or damage to the telephone network or lines, to computer equipment, to voice mail machines or systems, to data or software, to online systems, servers or access providers; any loss of function because witnesses are not activated; congestion on the Internet; the security or privacy of information transmitted via computer or telephone networks; or any breach of privacy due to interference by hackers.
 - ix) **Amendment.** The Contest Organizer reserve the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or halt this contest in whole or in part should an event, an error or any human intervention occur that could corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness or proper conduct of the contest, as provided for in these rules, and subject to the approval, if required.
 - x) **Limitation of prizes.** In any case, the Beneficiaries and suppliers of products or services related to this contest shall not be held to award more prizes than indicated in the rules herein or to award prizes other than in accordance with the rules herein.
 - xi) **Impossibility to act – labour dispute.** Beneficiaries shall not be liable in any way in all cases where their inability to act would result from an event or situation beyond their control (earthquake, war, act of terrorism, fire, flood, storm, riot, insurrection, civil unrest, fire or other force majeure) or a strike, lockout or any other labour dispute in their establishments or in the establishments of organizations or companies whose services are used to hold this contest.
 - xii) **Limitation of liability – participation.** By participating or attempting to participate in this Contest, participants release the Beneficiaries from all responsibility for any damage they may incur due to their participation or attempted participation in the contest.
 - xiii) **Authorization.** By entering this Contest, any winning participant authorizes the Contest Organizer, Beneficiaries and their representatives to use, if required, their name, photograph, image, declaration regarding the prize, place of residence and/or voice without any form of compensation and at their discretion, without limit as to the period of use in any social media or website and globally, for advertising purposes or any other purpose deemed relevant. A statement to this effect will be included in the Declaration Form.
 - xiv) **Ownership of Entry Forms.** Entry forms [and requests for participation without purchase] are the property of the Contest Organizer and will in no case be returned to participants.
 - xv) **Communication with participants.** No communication or correspondence will be exchanged with participants in this contest except with those selected for a prize.
 - xvi) **Personal information.** The personal information gathered about participants in connection with this Contest will be used solely by the Contest Organizer, the Prize Sponsor and their representatives in the administration of this contest. No communication, commercial or otherwise, unrelated to this contest will be sent to a participant, unless the participant expressly authorizes it.
 - xvii) **Decisions of the Contest Organizer.** Any decision of the Contest Organizer, Prize Sponsor or their representatives regarding this contest is final and cannot be appealed

- xviii) **Identification of the participant.** For the purposes of the rules herein, the participant is the person whose name appears on the Entry Form (or elsewhere, such as on a request for participation without purchase). It is to this person to whom the prize will be awarded if he or she is selected and declared the winner.
- xix) **Unenforceable paragraph.** If any section of the rules herein is declared illegal, unenforceable or invalid by a competent court that section shall be considered invalid, but all other paragraphs not affected will be enforced to the extent permitted by law.
- xx) **Jurisdiction.** This contest is subject to all applicable local, provincial and federal laws and regulations.
